We are a registered charity providing services to people with a learning disability who live in Kirklees. We are affiliated to, but not financially supported by, Royal Mencap. We deliver a range of services such as residential care, supported living, community support and day services, to adults with a learning disability across the Kirklees area, mostly under contract to Kirklees Council. We receive lottery funding to provide employment training through our café and Maintenance Trainee schemes and are part of a successful campaign group with other local providers. We deliver the Safe Places scheme for vulnerable adults and a number of projects for people who are not eligible for social care support. Our annual turnover is in the region of £3m per year and we employ 140 staff.
